The collaboration shall not be exclusive to both parties and shall not disallow each party from having similar collaboration with others. Except as expressly stated in this MOU, there shall be no obligation on any party to compensate the other in any manner.

Each party shall ensure that the other is not put to any liability for any actions. The MOU cannot be assigned to third party, without the prior written consent of the other party.

Validity and Termination

The MOU shall be valid for a period of 5 years from the date and each party shall be at full liberty either to renegotiate or terminate the collaboration with a notice period of 3 months.

Amendment or Modifications:

This MOU may be modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of both parties with mutual consent.

Confidentiality:

Absolute confidentiality of the information exchanged between the parties concerning the subject matter of this MOU shall be strictly maintained.

Legal Effect & Dispute Resolution:

The parties agree that the provisions contained in the MOU do not create any legal obligations between the parties, as in confidentiality provision and termination provision in this MOU. In case of a dispute relating to any aspect of cooperation, authorized representatives of both parties will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.

Governing Law:

This MOU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India.

Party 1 and Party 2 welcome the establishment of this Memorandum for understanding and jointly agree to the provisions above.
