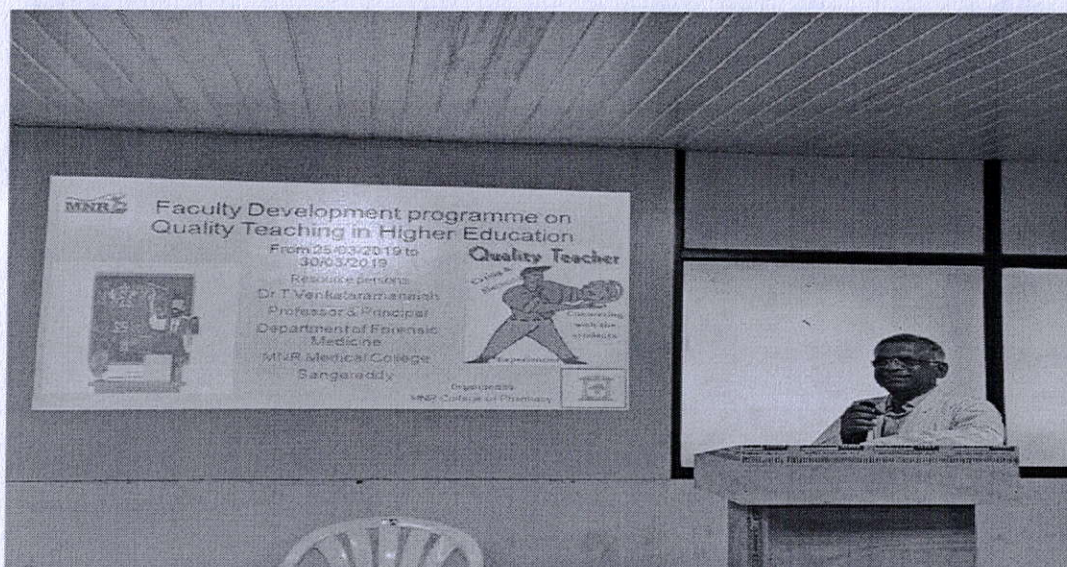
**Outcome of the Programme:**

To evaluate which mechanism really improves the quality of the teacher, one must assess the level of teaching before the launching of the enhancement initiative. Once the programme is well started the quality of teaching must again be meaningful. And for such an initiative to be truly effective the level of teaching must continue to be assessed very regularly. If lecturers believe that the students cannot be fair judges of the quality of their teaching, then they are less likely to follow up and change their practices. Teachers who follow up on quality assurance schemes are those who follow up on quality assurance schemes have control over the quality of education received.
