




**Winner for Bathukamma making is M. Manisha from B.Pharmacy 1<sup>st</sup> year B section.**

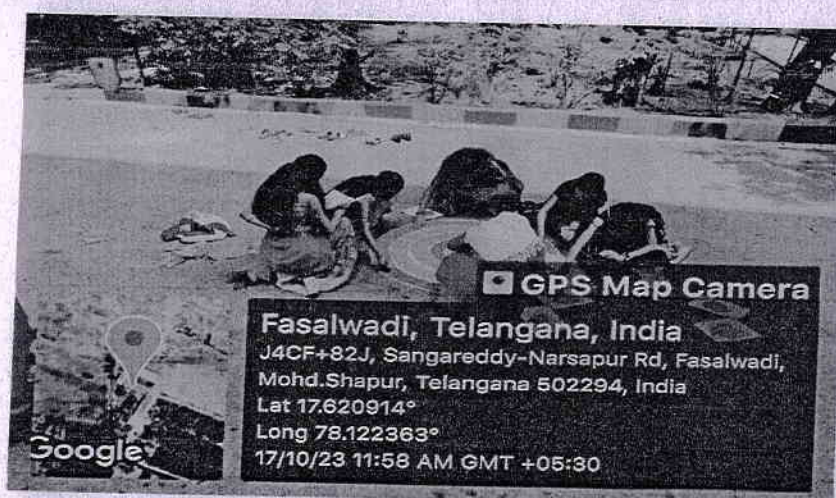

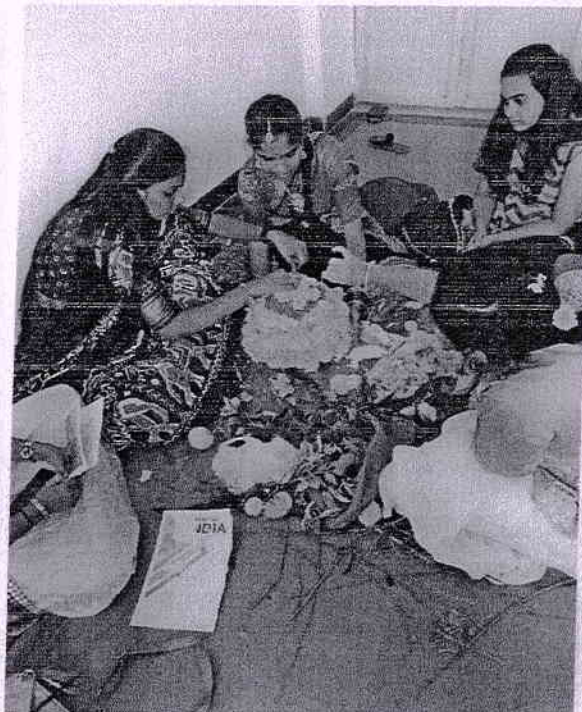

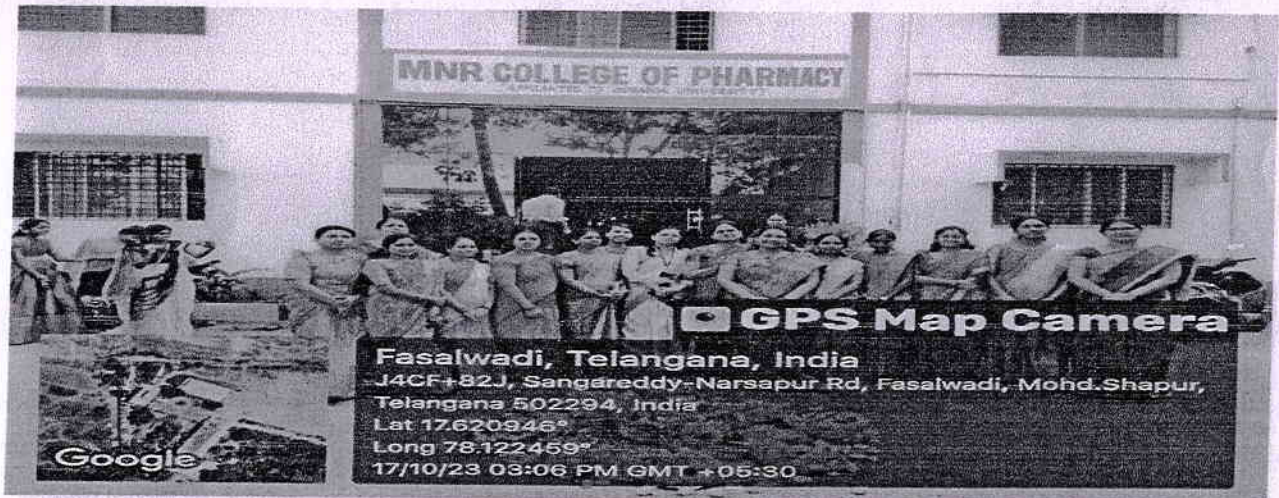
